



Corporate Volunteer Program

Thank you for your interest in the **CCLC's Corporate Volunteer Program**. We offer event and program volunteering. All corporate volunteer teams are required to attend a short training session (the CCLC can come to your workplace) and your HR department or team leader must submit a criminal check declaration for all those volunteering. All volunteers must be over 18 years of age.

Events

The CCLC hosts several community events in London. We welcome the support of corporate groups to help us set up/tear down and much more! We offer full and half day opportunities.

Harvestfest – Help children carve pumpkins and decorate a haunted house! This event takes place around Halloween from 5 - 8 pm at a local high school. Half day.

International Women's Day – women volunteers only please. A day to celebrate the accomplishment of women on March 8, 2019. This event takes place in the evening.

March Break Camp – Help children with arts and crafts at the CCLC. March 11-15, 2019 during the day. Full or half day.

Celebration of Nations – outdoor event with food vendors, crafts and a friendly soccer tournament. This event takes place on a weekend at a City of London park in August 2019. Some heavy lifting may be required. Full or half day.

Mentoring (Mutual Assistance Program) – an opportunity to help newcomers on a one-on-one basis within a group setting. Topics: youth and adult financial literacy, internet safety, mortgages & credit cards, studying for a driver's licence, and studying for the citizenship exam. Full or half day.

Walking group – Help newcomers discover our beautiful city by exploring our numerous walking paths or London's diverse neighbourhoods. Half day.

Josephs' House – Our house provides temporary accommodations for newly arrived refugee claimants. We welcome people from all over the world who have fled their home countries in fear of persecution. Teams would help clean, paint, and provide basic maintenance. Full or half day.
